About the Survey



*Confederation
of Tomorrow*

The Confederation of Tomorrow surveys give voice to Canadians about the major issues shaping the future of the federation and their political communities.

They are conducted annually by an association of the country's leading public policy and socio-economic research organizations.

The 2025 Study

The 2025 study consists of a survey of 5,391 adults, conducted between May 1 and June 16, 2025 (92% of the responses were collected between May 6 and May 29); 90% of the responses were collected online.

The remaining responses were collected by telephone (both landline and cell phone) from respondents living in the North or on First Nations reserves, or from francophone respondents in New Brunswick.
