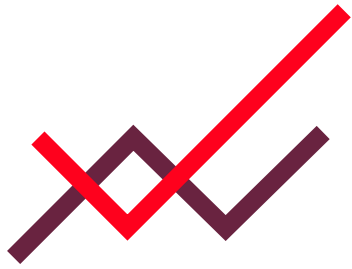

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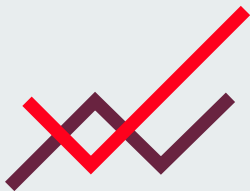
Global Issues Survey

The survey was conducted online between May 7 and 14, 2026 with a sample of 1,500 adult residents of Canada.
